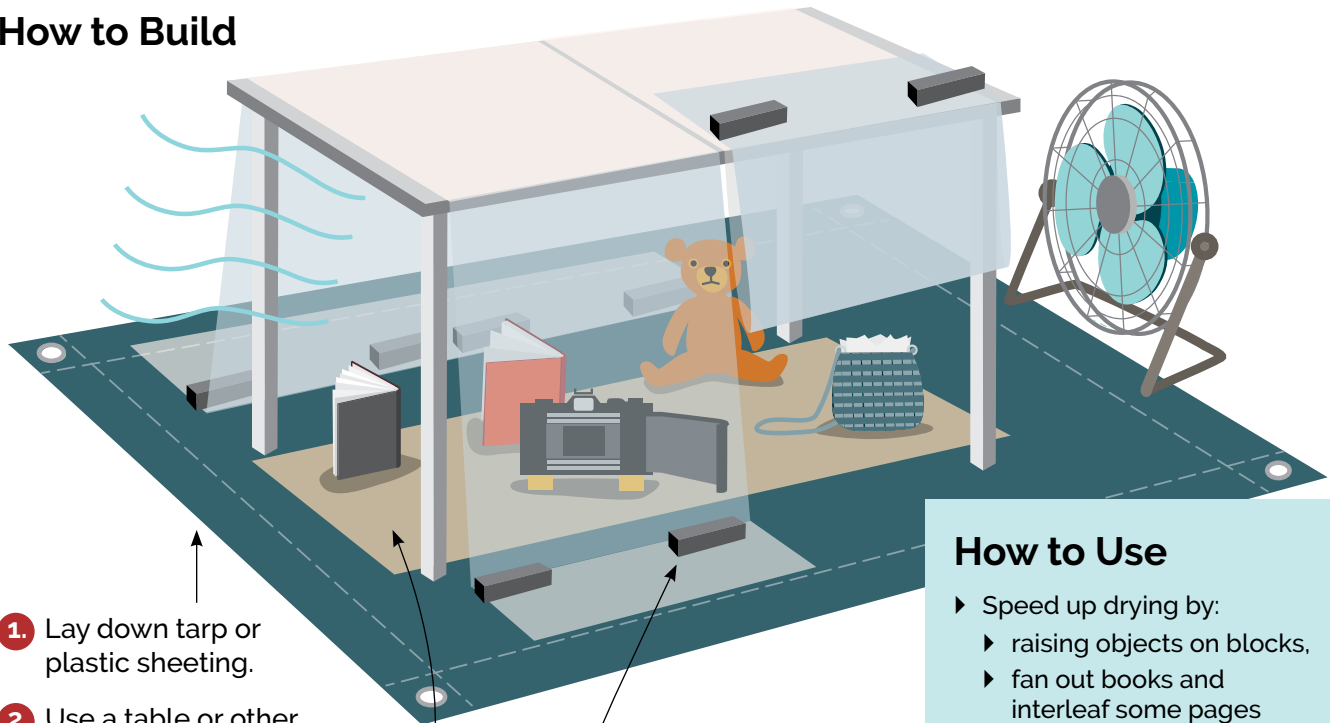


HOW TO:

Build and Use a Tunnel to Quickly Dry Collections



How to Build

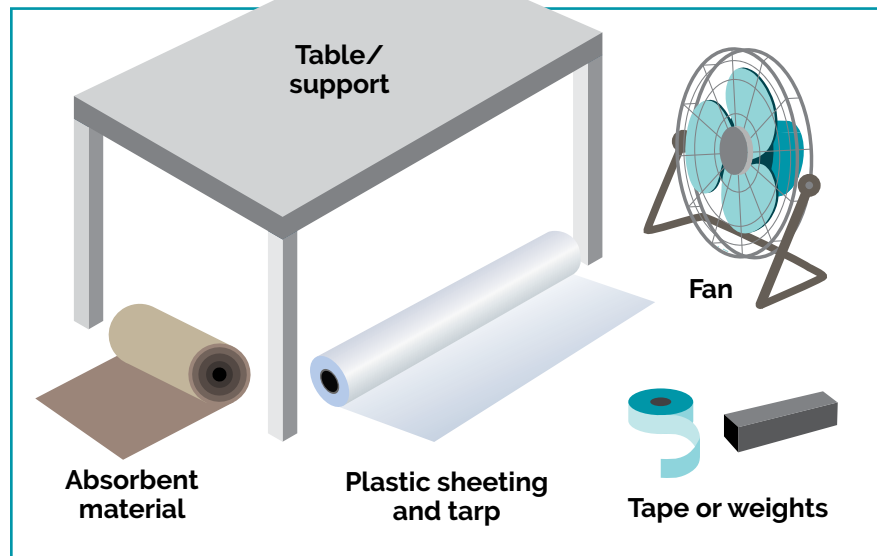


1. Lay down tarp or plastic sheeting.
2. Use a table or other support covered in plastic sheeting to create a tunnel, ensuring you have side access to objects.
3. Lay sheets of absorbent material inside tunnel.
4. Secure the plastic sheeting to the tarp using weights or tape.
5. Put a fan at one end, set on low, non-oscillating, no heat.

How to Use

- ▶ Speed up drying by:
 - ▶ raising objects on blocks,
 - ▶ fan out books and interleaf some pages with absorbent materials,
 - ▶ stuff interior spaces of bags, baskets and clothing with absorbent materials,
 - ▶ and turn over objects as they dry.
- ▶ Monitor for mould.
- ▶ Remove objects when dry to make space.
